

106 D. 2.1) Help Desk and Support Network - Rainwater Harvesting, Ground Water Recharge & Water Management Programme for Bengaluru City



Government of Karnataka through BWSSB has made harvesting of roof top rain water mandatory for most of the properties in Bangalore since 2011. KSCST in collaboration with BWSSB has established RWH Helpdesk at Sir M.Visweswaraya RWH Theme Park, Jayanagar and KSCST to create awareness and training programs to promote Rain water harvesting in Bengaluru city.

Around 87 training programmes have been conducted since inception and 3 Training Programmes have been conducted during the reporting Period for Architects, Plumbers, Contractors and Engineers.



Around 150 awareness programs have been conducted for general public and students since inception and around 8 Awareness Programmes on RWH have been conducted during the reporting period. 55,000+ visitors and 35,000+ students have visited RWH help desk. About 40% of visitors got benefitted and adopted RWH in their respective premises.
