2. Background of District NRDMS Centre, Yadgiri:

3. Geographical Features:

A. Location & Boundaries:

Yadgir District is one of the 31th districts of Karnataka state in southern India. This district was carved out of Kalburgi district as the 30th district of Karnataka on 10 April 2010. It is also the administrative headquarters of Yadgir taluk, one of the six taluks of the district.

B. **History** 

The town was under the Western Chalukyas in the ancient period. The name Yadgir

(Yadgiri, historically known as *Yetagiri*) is derived from its early medieval rulers.

Yadavs from the present-day Andhra Pradesh. A certain Mohammed Kasim was said

to be a strong chieftain who ruled Yadgir for a long period after defeating the

Yadavs, though there is no historical evidence to support it. Later, it came under the

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reign of the Bahamani Sultanate, the Bijapur Sultanate and finally, the Nizams of Hyderabad. A major economic development of the city took place under Philip Meadows Taylor, the administrator of the principality of Shorapur.

### C. Overview

Yadagiri, historically known as *Yetagir*, it is dotted with many historical monuments and has a majestic hill fort with three rounds of fortifications. There are three ancient temples, medieval mosques, tanks and wells on top of the hill. The barren landscape below offers a magnificent view. A tank, the Sanna Kere is located in the heart of the town.

### D. **Divisions**

Presently, the district comprises Six taluks: Shahpur, Surpur, Yadgir, Gurmitkal, Wadgire, Hunsagi. The district has 16 hoblies, 122 Gram Panchayets, 745 villages (inhabited & uninhabited) and four municipalities.

## E. **Geography**

The District is spread over an area of 5234.41 KM. Bhima River flows through Yadgir town. Still today people of yadagiri never faced water problem and also Krishna River Flows across the District.

## **Topography:**

Yadgir district's includes fertile plains in the Krishna and Bhima river basins, characterized by vast stretches of black cotton soil, and a location on the Deccan Plateau at approximately 693 meters above sea level. The region is also marked by hills, such as the one featuring the historic Yadgir fort, and the unique "Sleeping Buddha Hill" near Shahapur, which forms a prominent geographical landmark.

Key Topographical Features

• Deccan Plateau Location:


The district is situated on the Deccan Plateau, a large, physiographic region known for its volcanic origin.

• Fertile Plains:

Significant areas consist of fertile plains with black cotton soil, particularly in the river basins of the Krishna and Bhima, supporting agriculture.

• River Systems:

The rivers Krishna and Bhima flow through the district, contributing to irrigation and suitable conditions for human habitation and agriculture.

## Hills and Forts:

The district features hills, notably the hill at Yadgir town, which is surmounted by a historic fort with a multi-tiered fortification. Another significant landmark is "Sleeping Buddha Hill," a unique rock formation near Shahapur that resembles the figure of a sleeping Buddha.

## • Elevated Landscape:

The district is located at an elevation of approximately 693 meters (2,274 feet) above mean sea level.
